



Reindeer Pouch

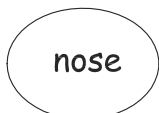

Materials:

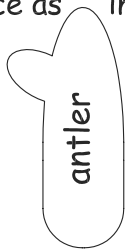
- tan, red, and brown felt
- tan, red, brown and black embroidery floss
- snap closure, fiber fill or cotton stuffing

Instructions:

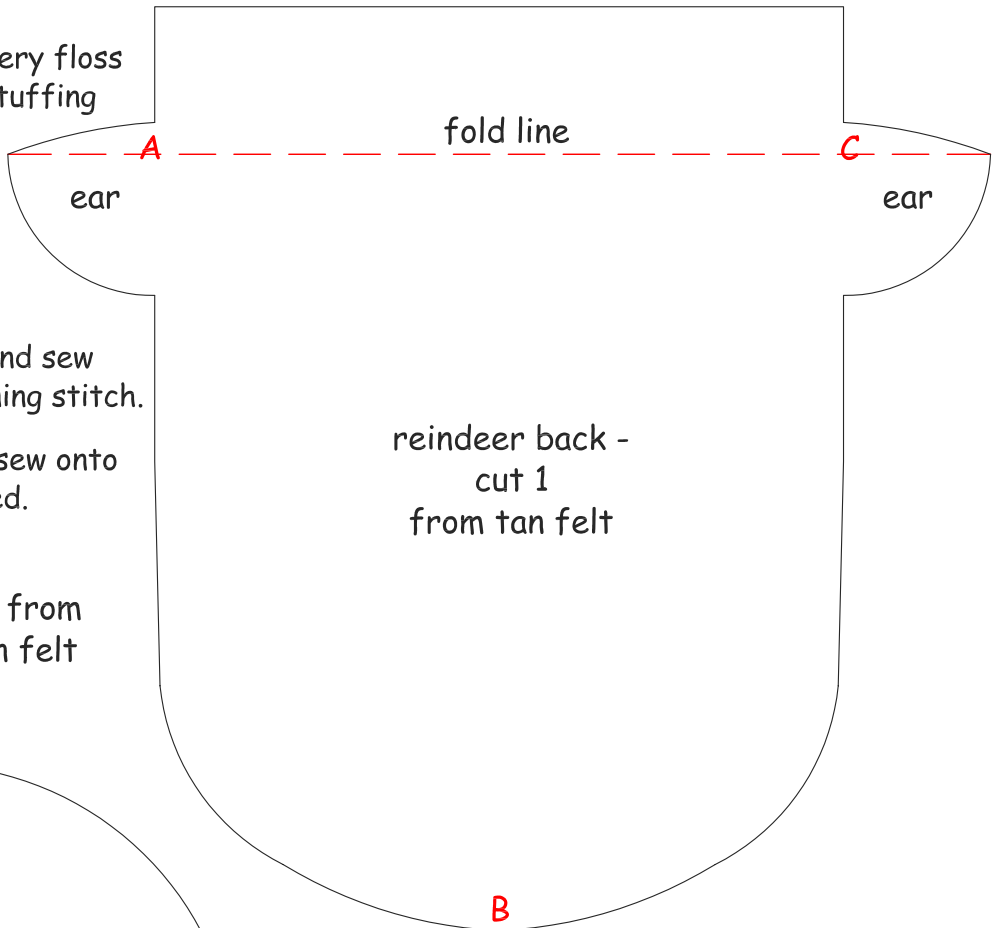
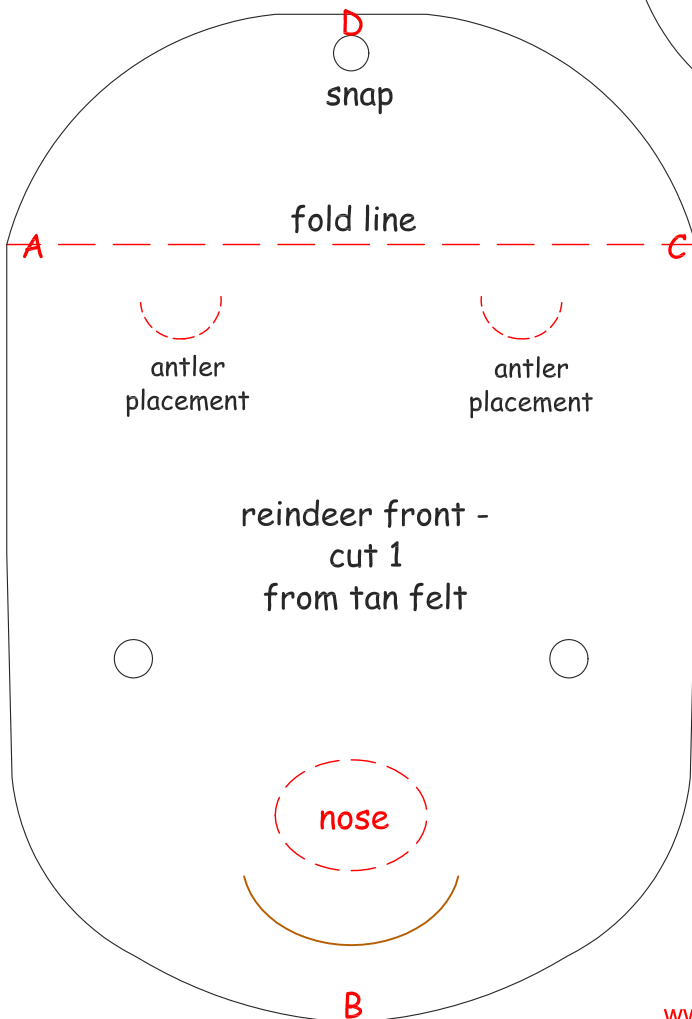
1. Cut front/back of pouch from tan felt, transfer face markings on to pouch front.
2. Fold back piece along fold line and sew in place along the edge with a running stitch.
3. Cut out nose from red felt and sew onto front of pouch piece as indicated.

4. Using black floss, outline the eyes with a backstitch, then use a satin stitch to fill in. Use brown floss and a back stitch for the mouth.
5. Leave front pouch piece unfolded and pin the front piece and folded back piece together (right sides out). Use a blanket stitch to sew front to back piece, from A to B and then B to C (do not sew along outer edge of ears). Finish from C to D to A of front pouch with a blanket stitch if desired.
6. Cut out 4 pieces of antler from brown felt. Use a blanket stitch to sew two pairs together. Lightly stuff with fiberfill before closing. Slightly angle the antlers outward and tack down to pouch front as indicated on pattern.
7. Use a q-tip or cotton swab to brush on powder blush for rosy cheeks and ears. Finish with a sewn snap on the back.



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
